After much deliberation, and sadness, I think our time in the Cristallina House has come to an end. The last 10 years have been quite the journey to say the least (especially the winters)! We thank you for sharing your home with us for all these years.

Work and Life have forced our hand and we've decided to turn the page on this chapter.

Lanie accepted a federal contract job (9 months) traveling the country taking samples, doing research, etc. And this job is primarily in the field. After which, we will settle where her job takes her next and sadly, the chances of that being the Tahoe area is next to zero.

For me, I have been considering a roommate for the next 9 months (with your permission of course), but I would just be delaying the inevitable. So, I think this may be a good opportunity for me to use this interim period to spend more time with my parents. They are in their 80s and I may not get this opportunity again. I plan on moving below the snowline, so I will be able to have more access to them during these upcoming winter months.

So, with all that said, we will be out of the house by 12/1/2024.

Execution

When we moved into this house, it was completely empty. We furnished it fully and continually over the last 10 years. We are members of the several local housing groups in the area and we've noticed that most homes for rent are at least partially furnished. Additionally, most of the people looking for places to stay are ski workers looking for furnished homes for the ski season (6 - 9 month leases). We've talked it over, and we are willing to part ways with a variety of the furnishings we've added to this house if you found this to be of value to you. These furnishings would be: washer, dryer, fridge, couches, coffee table, computer desk, guest bed, dressers, bookshelf, bar stools and a variety of kitchenware.

But, we can take it or leave it, this is entirely up to you.

If we take it, we'll just offer the things we don't need to the community and keep the rest. If we leave it, we'll leave the things you find of value and we'll take the rest. Either way is fine with us.

Cooperation

We would like this to be a seamless transition for both parties. This is primetime for ski leases, so we have no doubt that you will find new tenants. We are willing to take pictures and make a posting(s) on your behalf in the local housing groups and forward you the leads that come from them. This will also be helpful if we are coordinating on the furnishings we may leave behind. I will also be willing to schedule tours with those who are prime candidates.
